EZPull TX4S Quick Guide

Super-Sporting

When the TX4S is set to Super Sporting mode:

- 1. Singles: Press any target key: 1-A, 2-B, 3-C or 4-D.
- 2. Two keys true pair: Pressing any two target keys simultaneously throws a true pair.
- 3. True pair Using TP key:
 - 3.1. Press the center key (TP). Both T1 and T2 lights are flashing indicating no targets selected.
 - 3.2. Select the first trap using target keys 1-4. The T1 light glows steady. The T2 still flashing indicating you need to select a second trap.
 - 3.3. Select the second trap. Both lights will glow steady indicating the pair is ready for release. If you do not select both traps within 6 seconds, the pair request will timeout
 - 3.4. To change the pair selection, simply press another target key. The newly selected trap will replace the first trap selected.
 - 3.5. To select a Rafael pair, select the same trap twice. The second target will follow in the delay set in the EZPull Trap receiver (Typically 2.4 seconds.)
 - 3.6. When the shooter calls "*pull*", press the TP key again to release the pair.
 - 3.7. To abort pair selection, press any two keys simultaneously.
 - 3.8. Once both traps are selected, you have one minute (60 seconds) to throw the targets. After one minute, the pair requests will timeout.
- 4. True pair lock: It is possible to lock the True Pair selection so the same pair can be released repeatedly by pressing only the TP key.
 - 4.1. Press <u>and hold</u> the center key (TP) until the center light turns on (about 1.5 Seconds). Release the TP key. Both T1 and T2 lights are flashing indicating no targets selected.
 - 4.2. Select the first trap using target keys 1-4. The T1 light glows steady. The T2 still flashing indicating you need to select a second trap.
 - 4.3. Select the second trap. Both lights will glow steady indicating the pair is ready for release. If you do not select both traps within 6 seconds, the pair request will timeout
 - 4.4. To change the pair selection, simply press another target key. The newly selected trap will replace the first trap selected.

- 4.5. To select a Rafael pair, select the same trap twice. The second target will follow in the delay set in the EZPull Trap receiver (Typically 2.4 seconds.)
- 4.6. When the shooter calls "*pull*", press the TP key again to release the first pair.
- 4.7. After the first pair, the center light will blink indicating locked pair mode. To release the pair again, press the TP key.
- 4.8. To abort locked pair mode, press any of target keys 1-4.
- 4.9. Locked pair mode will timeout if you do not release another paid within 90 seconds.

Standard Sporting Clays

When the TX4S is set to Standard Sporting mode:

- 1. Singles: Press target key 1-A or 2-B.
- 2. True pair 1 + 2: Press the center key (TP).

Delayed Pair with Solo Delay on TX4S

When set to solo delay, the TX4S can throw a delayed pair to simulate a report pair:

- 1. Press any target key: 1-A, 2-B, 3-C or 4-D for the first target. The T1 light glows steady and the center light blinks.
- 2. Immediately press any target key 1-A, 2-B, 3-C or 4-D for the second target. The T2 light flashes rapidly.
- 3. For a Rafael pair, press the same key twice.
- 4. The first target will launch 3 seconds after pressing the first key. The second target will follow after the delay selected in the settings (see TX4S Setup Manual).

Delayed Pair with Solo Delay on TX4S_Pro

When using TX4S_Pro for TargetManager card system, a solo shooter can throw a delayed pair to simulate a report pair:

- 1. Use a card with Solo Delay or if TargetManager is in Sporting Clays with delay mode, press keys [2], [3] or [4] for a respective delay in seconds.
- 2. Press any target key: 1-A, 2-B, 3-C or 4-D for the first target and immediately press any target key 1-A, 2-B, 3-C or 4-D for the second target.
- 3. For a Rafael pair, press the same key twice.
- 4. The first target will launch after the solo delay period.
- 5. The second target will launch after another solo delay period.
